1938
Built our own building and moved to a new location at the intersection of Colorado Avenue and Osceola Street

We introduced the area's first drive-thru banking window—redefining convenience long before it became the norm

Changed our name to First National Bank of Stuart

Built our new corporate headquarters at U.S. 1 and Colorado Avenue in Stuart

Changed our name to First National Bank and Trust Company of Stuart
